## Signs and Symbols Scavenger Hunt

<b>Crescent and star</b> This is a symbol of Islam as is the name of god or the greatest name	<b>Ship</b> A ship or a boat could mark the grave of a sailor, it is also a symbol for taking a journey.	<b>Lamb</b> Jesus as the lamb of God, also a symbol of gentleness and innocence	<b>Star of David or 6</b> <b>Pointed Star</b> This is a symbol of Judaism or a Masonic symbol
Hands Hands clasped means a close bond like a marriage. Hands pointing down is thought to mean a sudden death and pointing up means heaven.	<b>Cross</b> You may find different types of cross but they all symbolise a strong Christian faith.	<b>Book or scroll</b> This could symbolise faith or a scholar. The book may be a bible symbolising a religious person or a prayer. A scroll is a symbol of life and time.	<b>Dove</b> This is a symbol of the Holy Spirit and of the release of the soul after death
<b>Wreath</b> This is a symbol of victory over death	<b>Tools of the Trade</b> You may find a symbol that shows a job or hobby. An anvil or hammer could be the symbol of a blacksmith. A violin could be a symbol	<b>Ivy</b> Ivy has many meanings including memory, immortality, friendship, faithfulness, undying affection and eternal life.	Urn This is a Greek symbol of mourning, symbolising sadness. An urn was originally used to put the ashes of the dead in ancient times.
